# About the school

- Vilnius Christian School is an evangelical school based in the capital of Lithuania;
- It upholds ecumenical stand, tries to preserve Christian values and nurtures students with believing educators.



The school was founded by Vilnius church “Word of faith” and started its activity in 1993 as a primary school. In 1995, it acquired the status of main school (5<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> grades). Since 2010, it became a secondary school providing education from 1<sup>st</sup> up till 12<sup>th</sup> grades.



- The school is a private educational entity.
- It works under license from Lithuanian Ministry of Education and Science, and implements national educational policy on its own account in accordance with the Department of Education. The School awards nationally accepted certificates, registered in The Ministry of Education and Science.



- Classes in the school are formed to be smaller than in state secondary schools which allows educators to observe each child and recognize individual abilities.

# Teachers

- Educators are qualified, experienced, constantly learning believers from various Christian communities.



Realizing that personality of the educator has the biggest impact for students we choose teachers without bad habits.

- Teachers not only participate in the organized development courses but also give lectures to parents and other teachers themselves.

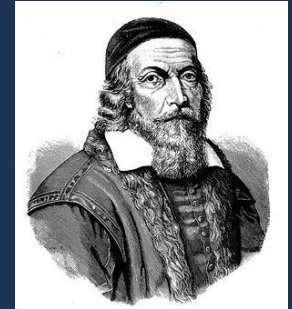

# Philosophy of Christian education

- All educational systems are grounded on certain world view. Values and attitudes are communicated (consciously or unconsciously) during each lesson. Every adult has his own thinking about God, nature, human being, etc. Every subject at school might be taught from the particular point of view (materialistic, humanistic, evolutionistic, etc.).
- Christian educational philosophy highlights the aim to nurture pious personality after Christ's character looking towards life in accordance with the Holy Scripture.

- Our school is grounded on continuous nurture principle, which means that values coming from a believing family later are uphold at school. This way children are prevented from misguiding dualism when religious life is separated from everyday life. Children are motivated to look into the world as an integral result of one Creator and encouraged to follow evangelical principles in everyday life.

While shaping values of the children we follow J. A. Comenius's ideas:

# Admission to school

- Children are admitted to pre-school group and classes from 1 to 11.
- To enter the child into school you have to fill in the application form at the school office.
- The tuition fee is:
  - For one child – 450 Litas per month;
  - For two children – 800 Litas per month;
  - For three children – 900 Litas per month.
- Discounts are given to:
  - Families bringing several children to our school;
  - Orphans;
  - Single-parented families
  - Families having children with disabilities

# Extra-curricula activities

- Parents who has not opportunities to pick their children right after school (pre-schoolers and 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> graders) have the opportunity to leave their children at an afternoon group where children engage into to kinds of activities: first they do their homework, and then the teacher offers some leisure activities.
- Children also can choose to attend some afterclass activities like computer ABC (1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> graders), sport, arts, modern dances, singing.
